SHOW TIME OR WORSHIP?

Church buildings were once looked upon as places of worship. Now these same structures are viewed as places that "meet the needs" of the whole person. Many religious groups are marketing their church through

means of recreation and entertainment. Everything to accommodate the family including "Family Life Centers" (gyms) to playgrounds is on the "drawing card" for the 21st century church. The mega-churches have really gone all out to capitalize on the craving for modern man: Theaters, bowling alleys, cafes, and large auditoriums to accommodate the "gospel" rock groups to entertain the young people which draws thousands to satisfy the flesh.

The instrument (piano, organ) which made its entrance into the assembly without Scriptural authorization (Col. 3:17) has now expanded to orchestras. Not only are people entertained by choruses, and solos, now drama and dance have been accepted in many places as acceptable expressions of "worship."

Friends, there simply is no Scriptural authorization for recreation and entertainment as a work of the church! The only drawing power that has heaven's approval is the glorious Gospel of Jesus Christ (Mark 16:15-16; Rom. 1:16). Some have attempted to justify the use of dramatic reading, drama and dance as simply a method of presenting the Gospel. This cannot be the case for the following reasons:

- 1. In order for any method to be used it must first and foremost be Scriptural. Dramatic reading, drama and dance fail the test since there is no authorization for them in the Scriptures (Col. 3:17)! It isn't unusual after a "performance" that many will burst forth in a resounding applause. Actually, these things cheapen worship; making it a spectator event, and takes away the praise and honor due only to the Almighty!
- 2. All worship must be directed to God "in spirit and in truth" (John 4:24) and not for the purpose of elevating or exalting man! The simplicity of God-approved worship consists of Singing praises unto God (Eph. 5:19, without the use of instruments of music), Prayers (Acts 2:42), Preaching (Acts 2:42), partaking of the Lord's Supper (1 Cor. 11:23-29; Acts 20:7), and Giving of one's means as God has prospered them (1 Cor. 16:1-2). Remember, friends, additions to God-ordained worship results in "vain worship" that God rejects (Matt. 15:8-9; Gal. 2:21-23)!

John informs us of the great AWE (reverence) demonstrated in heaven toward Almighty God when he wrote: "...And the four and twenty elders fell down and worshiped him that liveth forever and ever. ... And all the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders, and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshiped God" (Rev.5:14; 7:11). My friends, the atmosphere of the assembly must reflect Him whose presence we are to honor and praise!

As we enter the assembly let us remember we are in the presence of God. We are not there for a show or to be entertained, but to worship the great I AM (Exodus 3:14). His holiness, His greatness, His goodness, and His severity, demands we worship Him and Him alone "in spirit and in truth" (John 4:24)! PO Box 92 West Plains, MO 65775

"THE CHURCHES OF CHRIST SALUTE YOU" (Rom. 16:16)

In this age of marketing the church, many denominations, and unfortunately some churches of Christ have decided to change their name. Their reasons vary: a new emphasis, a Different location, a new "face lift," a merger, a Division, Doctrinal barriers, etc. It is interesting to note many have dropped "church" from their new identity; e.g. The Branch, The Crossing, Grace Pointe, The Grove, The Mount, The Journey, etc. Others have the idea that any name is acceptable such as: The Cowboy Church, Endurance Church, The Bikers Church and even the Church of Schizophrenia. It is very apparent that many are of the persuasion that there is nothing in a name. Yet, their inconsistency is readily seen when it comes to marriage, naming of children, name of a business, one's beneficiary, and identifying of criminal's names.

We are exhorted to "speak as the oracles of God" (1 Peter 4:11), and in so doing we will call "Bible things by Bible names!" Denominations and denominational names are without biblical authority (Col. 3:17) because they are not speaking as the oracles of God (1 Peter 4:11)! The inspired words of Paul in 1 Cor. 1:10-13 is a riveting denunciation of party names which create division!

As one searches the Scriptures he will discover that "the church" has no given name. In other words, there is no one exclusive name for the church, but is spoken of in many scriptural designations: "the church" (Acts 8:1), "the house of God" (1 Tim. 3:15), "the temple of God" (1 Cor. 3:16), "the church of God" (1 Cor. 1:2), "the church of the living God" (1 Tim. 3:15), "the general assembly" (Heb. 12:23), "the church of the firstborn" (Heb. 12:23), and "the churches of Christ" (Rom. 16:16). All of these designations have reference to the one church of the New Testament which clearly identifies the church belonging to deity!

Paul's letter to the Romans was written in 57 or 58 A.D. Toward the close of the epistle he wrote, "The churches of Christ salute you" (Rom. 16:16). Friends, there was not one denomination on the face of the earth when Paul wrote those inspired words! There was only the one church that Christ established on the day of Pentecost (Acts 2:37-47)!

The word "churches" in Romans 16:16 has reference to local congregations of the Lord's one church. Another example is "the seven churches which are in Asia" (Rev. 1:4). Meaning, the one church that belongs to Christ is found in these locations. Therefore, each congregation would be a "church of Christ!" Again, Christ is the head of the church which is His body (Eph. 1:22-23), and He purchased the church with His own blood (Acts 20:28). One cannot separate Christ from His church!

Without question, "Christ's church" or "the church of Christ" is a Scriptural designation of "the church" that belongs to Christ! Let us therefore wear the designation "the church of Christ" with dignity and honor to our risen Savior, Jesus Christ! "The churches of Christ salute you" (Rom. 16:16).
