ISRAEL IS AT WAR, AGAIN

Since Israel declared its independence as a nation in 1948, sixteen wars have been fought to retain its status as a nation. They are:

The War of Independence (1947-1949)

Sinai War (1956)

Six-Day War (1967)

War of Attrition (1967-1970)

Yom Kippur War (1973)

Operation Litani (1978)

First Lebanon War (1982-1985)

Security Zone Campaign (1985-2000)

First Intifada (1987-1993)

Second Intifada (2000-2005)

Second Lebanon War (2006)

Operation Cast Lead (2008-2009)

Operation Pillar of Defense (2012)

Operation Protective Edge (2014)

2021 Israel-Palestine Crisis (2021)

Israel-Hamas War (2023).

The last eight of these wars (Lebanon was an interlude) have been with Hamas. Charlatan opportunists from very near the beginning of Israel's independence have written millions of books capitalizing on Israel's misery and duping gullible people into believing they have special insights into Israel's future. Virtually all of them are premillennialists. Well-known names among them are: John F. Walvoord, Hal Lindsay, Tim LaHaye, John Hagee, and David Jeremiah.

The Bible proves all these men to be charlatans. And, here's why:

Israel lost its favored nation status when Israel crucified Christ (Matt. 21:28-46).

Jesus knew He would be rejected by the Jews (Isaiah 53:1-12).

Jesus' kingdom, the church, was never intended to be a physical, material kingdom, but a spiritual one (John 18:36).

Jesus' kingdom is His church (Matt. 16:18-19; Col. 1:13; Heb. 12:28; Rev. 1:9).

The church was planned by God from eternity past (Eph. 3:10-11).

The church of Christ today is the Israel of God (Gal. 6:16).

Today, all Christians —not just Jews by physical descent —are referred to as Jews by an inspired apostle (Rom. 2:28-29).

All Israel will be saved by the same means as all Gentiles will be saved and that is by the new covenant which contains the Gospel of Jesus Christ (Rom. 11:1-36, esp. vs. 27-28; Heb. 8:6-13; Rom. 1:16; 6:1-18).

No signs forecast the second coming of Christ (Matt. 16:27; 24:36-44; John 5:28-29; 1 Thess. 5:1-6; 2 Thess. 1:7-10; 2 Peter 3:10-12; Rev. 1:7).

Any one of these nine biblical proofs sustain the conviction that all of these modern prognosticators are frauds. Together, they forge an unassailable case against these charlatans. Their efforts are skillfully designed to divert attention away from the Great Commission of Christ (Mark 16:15-16) and the church of Christ (Rom. 16:16) into which the Son of God has been adding all the saved since the day the Lord's church was established in Jerusalem, Israel in A.D. 33 (Acts 2:47).

The real problem Israel confronts today is the same problem Israel confronted in the first century. Paul wrote, "Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is, that they might be saved. For I bear them record that they have a zeal of God, but not according to knowledge. For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and going about to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God" (Rom. 10:1-3).

"And as many as walk according to this rule, peace be on them, and mercy, and upon the Israel of God."
